The project is the design and build of a timber framed nursery unit, in association with Sure Start Neighbourhood Nursery, with accommodation for a baby room, toddlers room, creche, ancillary areas, toilets and nappy changing facilities together with a link connection to the existing building and associated external works.

The building is brick clad external walls and a tiled pitched roof. Works to the existing nursery unit include a new corridor and an extended staff room. External works provide soft play area, shared nature area, footpaths, fencing, landscaping and enlarging the existing carpark.
