### Project specifications:

The project consisted of initially creating a new locker room and staffroom. This soon had its function changed to an IT suite, hidden away within the folds of the existing buildings of the newer part of the campus. Secondly, the brief was to create a modern Sixth Form Common Room out of what was a locker room. It also contained, in its decorations, representations of the Kings Ditch, which the room spans. The final phase was to create a new sixth form IT suite and careers department in one of the oldest parts of the building. An extension was added, recreating natural stonework and rubbed brick arches with extensive internal alterations.
