Project specifications:

This is the construction of a new lower school for Bedfordshire County Council that was built using a steel frame. With the external wall comprising of traditional construction using brick outer leaf and block inner leaf. All fully insulated to give a highly energy efficient building. The roof was built using duo pitched timber trusses finished with concrete interlocking roof tiles. Internally the floors were finished with either carpet or vinyl sheet flooring. The ceilings are smooth painted plaster with feature lighting.

The project was completed on time to ensure that the normal academic school year was not disrupted.
