Project specifications:

The construction of a new portal frame Trades building specially designed to provide training facility and three new business incubator units, male, female and disabled toilet facilities including a main reception area.

The structural steel frame was clad with metal insulation panels and cavity brickwork to ceiling height. Natural light into the building is provided by Sun pipes reducing solar gain significantly. External works included footpaths, cycle stands, fencing, hard and soft landscaping, access road and car parking.

Services included the provision of a new electrical sub station.
