Project specifications:

This school was extensively refurbished and extended in phases to allow the young students to move into the renewed areas as soon as they were available. With a brick outer leaf and a block inner leaf the external wall were of a traditional construction. The building was fully insulated to be highly energy efficient. The roof was built using duo pitched timber trusses and was finished with concrete interlocking roof tiles. Internally the ceilings have feature lighting and are finished with smooth paint plaster. The floors were finished with either vinyl sheet flooring or carpet.

To ensure the normal academic school was not disrupted the project was completed on time.
